Bene Taata omuri Kristo. Nimbaakiira ahakiro kikuru ky'okwija kwa Mutima Orikwera, niyo Pentikooti! Nitwijuka obu Mutima Orikwera yaija aha ntumwa hamwe na Nyinaitwe Biikira Maria obu babaire bateeraniire omukishengye kimwe omuri Yeruzalemu nibeshengyereza kandi bategyerereizeyo Mutima wa Mukama ou yabaire abaraganiise. Erizooba n'ekiro kya makumi ataano okuruga tukurize okuzooka kwa Kristo. Enamba ya makumi ataano niyo turikwihaho eiziina Pentikooti. Nitukuza okutandika kw'ekigombe ky'abaikiriza boona, niyo Ekerezia. Ahakiro kya Pentekooti nibwo Ekerezia yatandika kandi nubwo Ekigambo kya Mukama kyabanza kurangirirwa entumwa ze omuruteerane rwa Yeruzaremu hatariho kutiina. Manya Mutima Orikwera owabashuumireho akabahasirira, yabaijuza engabirano ze, yabahamya, yabaihamu omutima gw'okutiina yabaha obumanzi n'omujinya.

Mutima Orikwera ogwo akaba ariho ensi nehangwa kandi Ruhanga Taata na Ruhanga mwana bakakwatanisa nawe omukuhanga ensi; nitushoma ngu Ruhanga ku yabaire nahanga akaba abanza yaganiira na Mwana na Mutima Orikwera. Omukitabo ky'Okutandika nitushoma ngu Ruhanga akagira ati "katuhangye omuntu omukyeshusha kyaitu." Mutima Orikwera niwe yabaire aheereza abarangi amaani n'obumanzi bw'okubuzya Obutumwa bwa Ruhanga. Omurangi Isaaya naagira ati "Mutima wa Mukama ari ahariinye ahabwokuba akansiiga amajuta kwegyesa abooro ebigambo birungi." (Isaaya 61:1). On behalf of AMDA Exco and myself, I warmly welcome you all to our May Monthly Mass. Today, we gather to conclude the Easter Season by celebrating the Solemnity of Pentecost. It is a time when we commemorate the powerful presence of God among us through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, which has been bestowed upon the people of God throughout history and continues to bless us today. *Mwijure amaani ga mutima orikwera!*

I extend my heartfelt congratulations to the leadership of the St. Joseph's AMDA family, which unites AMDA members residing in Nansana and its surrounding areas, for ably animating this mass. Thank you!

Currently, AMDA comprises nine families spread across Kampala and its neighboring regions. They are as follows: Entebbe Road (St. Padre Pio AMDA Family), Ggaba Road (St. Andrew Kahwa AMDA Family), Jinja Road (St. Augustine AMDA Family), Nansana (St. Joseph AMDA Family), Namugongo (Uganda Martyrs AMDA Family), Gayaza Road (St. Peter the Rock AMDA Family), Kisaasi (St. Jude AMDA Family), Portbell Road (St. Jose Maria AMDA Family), and the recently launched Busega-Mityana Road-Kyengera-Nabingo (St. Andrew AMDA Family).

Each of these families aims to promote unity and solidarity among Christians in their respective communities, acting as one family through prayer and other social events. I urge all members to familiarize themselves with their respective families and actively participate in their activities, such as fellowships and other social events that foster our unity. It is equally important to engage in activities

organized by our parishes and Small Christian Communities, established by the Archdiocese of Kampala.

I would like to express my gratitude to the teams that diligently worked throughout the month to successfully implement the following activities:

- AMDA Pilgrimage to Kibeho: From May 11th to 14th, 2023, we embarked on our pilgrimage to Kibeho. Kibeho Parish has become a significant pilgrimage destination for Roman Catholics worldwide since the first apparition of Mother Mary on November 28th, 1981. Many pilgrims returned with renewed energy to embark on new lives, restore broken relationships, invest more in their spiritual journey, and continue witnessing miracles (ebyamagero).
- Rubaga AMDA Project: We have completed the final ring beam and water tank slab of the clergy section at Rubaga. The next stage involves roofing. I extend my heartfelt appreciation for your ongoing support for this noble cause.
- The first-ever AMDA Women Business Expo was successfully held on May 1st and 2nd, 2023, attracting hundreds of visitors and a few strategic partners. The Exco is currently reviewing the possibility of making this an annual event and expanding partnerships further.
- On May 25th, 2023, we had the privilege of commissioning our 12 deacons (3 at Ggaba and 9 at Kinyamasika), who have now returned to the Archdiocese to await the Ordinary's decision. A few of us attended the party organized at Ggaba National

Major Seminary in honor of the three deacons who have successfully graduated. We also presented gifts to the other deacons at Kinyamatsika National Major Seminary.

In the coming month of June, the members of AMDA Bereavement Fund (ABF) will hold their inaugural Meet and Greet meeting on June 17th, 2023.

During our ExCo's reflection on the MEPA bishops' call and the Catholic Church's initiative to revitalize ministry within Catholic families, we recognized the family as the domestic church where children are nurtured for God's purposes. We acknowledged the importance of every child growing up in a family with both parents and the challenges faced by Christian marriages due to forces seeking to devalue this institution.

As a result, we approved the proposal to establish the AMDA Marrieds' Council, whose primary role will be to animate, support, and encourage family ministry within AMDA. Similar to other Councils, the Marrieds' Council will operate under the auspices of the ExCo, with its core leadership nominated by the ExCo and reporting to it.

We appeal to all married individuals to actively participate in this council. Also, if you have someone in mind who you believe would make a suitable leader for this Council, please submit your nomination to the chaplain, Fr. Darius Magunda. Nominations will remain open until May 31st, 2023.

May you all experience a blessed month ahead.

The show hosted under the theme: 'Maximising Business Innovations in the Wake of Technology Advancements and Climate Change' attracted over 30 businesses and several show goers.

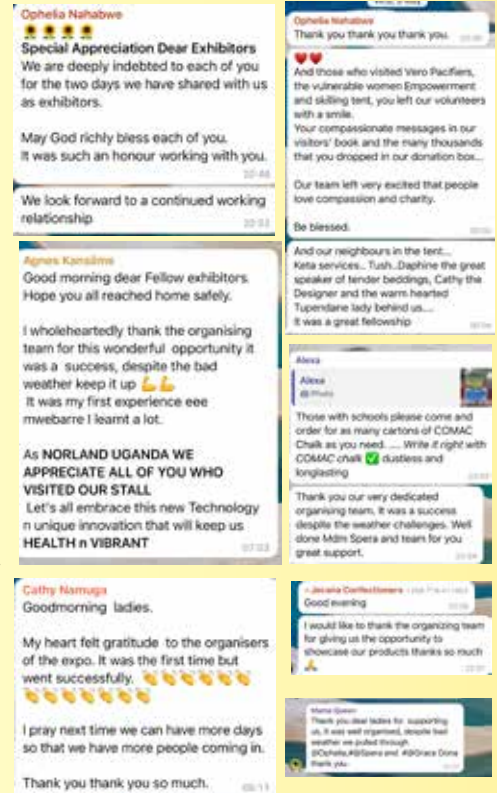
