

2018: Rwoho and Rushanje


2019: Kakindo and Mushanga

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A TRIBUTE TO "THE DEFENDER OF THE CATHOLIC FAITH"



Recently, Mushanga Parish and the whole country lost a beloved son, Mr David Bashakara who served the country and humanity at large in different capacities. The editorial team has extracted his own words from his memior book.



"Thank you God for giving me a gift of life!"

was born in 1948 to Yokaana Kachontori and Tefasi Bashoromire of Kitoohwa Village, Mushanga Parish, Sheema District"

"I started my school trek at Mushanga Primary School. In 1958, while in primary three, I was baptized in the Catholic Church by Fr. Peregoshe, who was the Parish Priest then at Mushanga after having successfully completed the Omugigi course. Surprisingly my parents also chose to be baptized in Church of Uganda a year later."

"Although all my parents and siblings were protestants, my mother would not allow them eat meat on Fridays... In spite of our different religious beliefs, we continued to live in harmony as a family."

"Politics of religions could not wait for long. My parents were influenced by some people that I should not be allowed to remain Catholic, that I should cross to the Kabwohe protestant school which I vehemently rejected. As a punishment for what my detractors called 'his stubbornness', I was discontinued from pursuing my studies at Mushanga Primary, a Catholic founded school."

"Consquently, I had to stay home doing domestic errands and petty trade. This reminds me of one incident when I took my fried groundnuts to Mushanga Primary to sell it to school children. I found them attending Mass, so I had to wait for them until they came out. Because I was short in height, some pupils took advantage of my shortness to pick the groundnuts from the basket I was carrying on my head. By the time I realized what was happening, the basket was almost empty!"

After a short spell at home, a family friend, the Late Kashemaire, introduced me to a school teacher, one John Munyarugyero, who employed me as a house boy. Later on however, Munyarugyero, came to know that I had been stopped from schooling in primary three, he sympathized with me and took me back to school. I stayed with teacher Munyarugyero, until he was transferred to Rushinya, St Kaggwa Primary School. Then I relocated to Kitabi Primary School for primary seven. Later on, I joined Kitunga High School for O-level Education, then to St. Henry's College Kitovu (A-Level) and Makerere University; finally coming out as a graduate of Political Science and Public Administration, in 1978.

Fresh from the University, I got employed immediately as Township Officer, eventually rising to the rank of Chief Township Officer(but always referred to as 'Town Clerk'. During the course of my employment, I got an opportunity to attend various courses and obtain different certificates. In 2010 I retired from public service of Uganda Government with a clean record. lam a senior citizen serving in the District Service of Uganda. I also earn my living by engaging in various agricultural activities, e.g. cattle husbandry, banana farming and afforestation.

I married Rose Mwebaze Bashakara a daughter to the late Mr. & Mrs. Bangotwire of Kizinda, Ishaka Bushenyi District. We took our marriage vows on 23rd August 1980 at St. Kaggwa Parish.

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INTERVIEW > A SENIOR EDUCATIONIST

MR BARINYENKA BONIFACE



The Editorial Team of this Magazine brings to you a brief interview with a Senior educationist Mr. Barinyenka Bonny a founding Headteacher of Sacred Heart S.S. Mushanga and St. Michael S.S. Rugazi and now serving at Nyakabanga S.S. in Igara Bushenyi District. We are glad to bring to you excerpts of this exchange:

Tarsis: I am happy to meet you Mr. Bonny Barinyenka after a very long time, how are you?

Mr. Barinyenka: I am delighted to reconnect with you Tarsis Kabogoza and I am fantastic.

Tarsis: As one of our Senior leaders in the education sector in our region, our readers would like to know who Mr. Barinyenka is?

Mr. Barinyenka: I am a 7o year old Male Ugandan who retired from government service after serving in quite a number of schools namely; Bweranyangi, St. Machael S.S Bunyaruguru, Sacred Heart Mushanga, later I briefly served in St. Noah- Mutara and finally at Ntare School as a first Deputy Headteacher and later retired at Nyakabanga S.S after a request from the Archbishop to step in and put some direction to a school that had stagnated after the death of its founder Headteacher, Mr. Busharizi.

Tarsis: This quite interesting. To know that a 70year old Ugandan is still vibrant and still manning such a big school as Nyakabanga. Why haven't you retired?

Mr. Barinyenka: My passion for quality Education and impacting on my community can't let me rest.

Tarsis: Wonderful! What a patriot you are.

Tarsis: You talked about the Archbishop requesting you to step in at Nyakabanga, why you? Should we assume that the there were no other people of age to serve? Why over stretch our beloved old man?

Mr. Barinyenka: The Archbishop is aware of my record of academic excellence.

Tarsis: That's good to hear from the "Horse's Mouth." What makes you special and how do you do it?

Mr. Barinyenka: Zero tolerance to indiscipline. The worst mistake many Head teachers/leaders do is tolerating indiscipline of any form that cut across from students to staff or even parents and leaders themselves. That's why some schools are into limbo.

Secondly, I embrace Godliness and Christian values

wherever I go/serve, thus students are led on strong Christian principles that propels them to success and eventual greatness.

Tarsis: You have talked about some schools being into limbo, I was getting tempted to list a few that used to roar 20 - 30 years ago but are now limping. What could have gone wrong?

Barinyenka: highlighted above, the greatest cause is indiscipline. Most leaders/ headteachers fail to separate institutions from their family/ personal affairs and end up using school/institutions' resources for their personal needs at the expense of the purpose they were put in place to do.

Some start on encroaching on their employees or even students which compromises their ability to give moral direction.

Thirdly, some foundation bodies are found interfering with the day today running of Institutions, or they are more interested in immediate financial benefits than the future that calls for sacrifice and hardwork.

Tarsis: Thanks elder for giving such insights. Having talked about foundation bodies and their role in the growth of these institutions, now specifically on Mbarara Archdiocese, to what extent is the Church doing her mandate?

Mr. Barinyenka: To a greater extent I can say. The Catholic Church in Mbarara has done and is still doing her mandate tremendously through her Diocesan Education Office. For a long time, this office has done a great



supervisory role and that's why most of our church founded schools are performing better. The same office has been key in choosing and sourcing of head teachers for most of these schools.

Tarsis: As a founder of Sacred Heart and St. Michael, our readers would like to know why such schools were created.

Mr. Barinyenka: Absolutely, there was demand for convenience to communities where these schools were set up. Students were moving long distances to access secondary education. Parents at the time wanted to have schools which they could control and secure the future of their children. Secondly there was need for affordable education to the local communities since the distant schools were charging high dues on top of high transport costs.

Tarsis: So are those schools still serving the purpose for which they were created?

Mr. Barinyenka: To some extent they are, while to some extent they are not. Unfortunately some schools like Sacred Heart have grown while the communities around have not necessarily grown with it. Many parents around can longer afford the standards at Sacred and are facing the same challenge of walking

to smaller schools for affordable fees. However, these schools have churned out great men and women who are serving the communities in different capacities. It's a great achievement to the founders. It's up to the founding bodies to ensure that communities benefit in a way of staffing and sponsorships to the most vulnerable in our communities.

Tarsis: What challenges are you leaders facing as you serve these schools?

Mr. Barinyenka: There are quite a number. There is lack of adequate infrastructure. There is when we are overwhelmed by numbers and we fail to adequately accommodate them or even offer the best services that are necessary to hit our target of excellence.

Secondary, there are sectarian tendencies emanating from politics, where some politicians are fond of sabotaging these schools on faith basis, which is regrettable.

Tarsis: Let me take this opportunity to thank you for sparing your quality time to attend to me. And also thank you for doing a great service to this country. May you be blessed.

Mr. Barinyenka: It's been a pleasure to host you after a long time. Thanks for good job you are doing as well. May God bless you.







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Dr. Stephen Birungi is a veterinary surgeon. He initially had a private practice at Ntinda Kampala, until the high prices and the high incidence of disease outbreaks associated with inefficacious drugs attributed to the illegal imports of substandard veterinary products became a common practice. Dr. Stephen Birungi is Alfasan founder managing director of the company, now ten years old and he is upbeat that considering that economic analysts have concluded that a Ugandan company that survives that long, has chances of living for ever after. In his estimation, Alfasan has taken off and has no reason to look backwards.

He opted to partner colleagues from Alfasan of The Netherlands, producers and distributors of veterinary medicine since 1985, to address the issue, effectively kicking in an enhanced entrepreneurial knack, ten years ago. They set up shop in Uganda to produce medicines of the authentic European standards albeit at the prices affordable to Ugandans.

Alfasan's veterinary drugs production is in three phases to produce injectables and oral liquids, Hydro soluble powders, acaricides and vaccines. While attributing the high cost of European originating pharmaceutical products to the cost of labour. Alfasan pays its staff at relatively higher levels than what the local market offers but at rates which are lower than those of Europe.

Thus with a lower cost of labour and packaging, whilst adhering to the Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP), a system for ensuring that products are consistently produced and controlled according to scientifically acceptable quality standards. The company's equipment has been imported from the Netherlands.

GMP covers all aspects of production; from the starting materials, premises and equipment to the training and personal hygiene


of staff. At home, the National Drug Authority regularly audits Alfasan's production processes and issues the company with certificate of authority.

In doing so, Alfasan will address the issue of drugs shortages and pricing, develop critical technical expertise and create employment for professional nationals in the veterinary Pharmaceuticals' sector and contribute to Buy Uganda Build Uganda, an economic development philosophy the government is promoting. Reacting to the incidence of foot and mouth disease which beset the herders prompting a declaration of quarantine Dr. Birungi is optimistic of Alfasan's rising to the occassion to find a solution through the manufacture of appropriate efficacious vaccines in the very near future, for which a laboratory for the purpose is already in place. He urges livestock owners to treat the vocation as serious businesses that are cautious of inputs, outputs and outcomes. They need to take professional advice seriously and strive only to apply authenticated efficacious drugs recommended by the veterinary practitioners, so as not to nurture diseases and pests which are resistant to eradication.

To further this ideal, the company has recently acquired two square miles of land on which it intends to set up an ideal farm; the animals will benefit from scientific innovations Alfasan will be generating.

Against this background, with a passion for professional development, Dr. Birungi urges his professional colleagues to junk the mentality of simply practicing veterinary medicine but find ways of enhancing their vocation to be more productive in national building. He says the company will also be hosting university veterinary students who undertake research into the development of various veterinary Pharmaceuticals.

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
