Isaaya 55:6-9; Abafilipi 1:20c-24,27a; Matayo 20:1-16a



Ruhanga tarikwingaanisa, kureka naringaaniza!

Mukama naagira, ati “**manya ebiteekateeko byangye tikyo kimwe n’ebyanyu**” (Is. 55:8).

Obumwe n’obumwe hariho obu ebintu bimwe birikutushobera, nangwa obariiremu n’emiteekateekyere n’emigirire ya Mukama. N’omu Baibuli noshangamu ebirikushobera abantu. Noyebuuza oti ahabwenki Ruhanga omuburungi bwe yahaire Adamu na Eva omusiri murungi gwa Edeni, akabaha ebijuma byamwo, kwonka akabazibira kurya ebijuma bya gumwe omu miti. Kikaba nikimwitsaki kubibarekyera byona?

Nitushoma omuri Luka 10:41-32 ngu Yesu kuyataayayiire Maria na Martha, Mariya we yaahugira ahambooji na Kristo, obwo Martha arikwehenenga n’okuteeka n’okugabura. I greet you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ... Mukama waitu Yezu nabakunda!

On behalf of the AMDA Executive Committee and personally, I would like to warmly welcome you for joining us in this month's Mass led by St. Andrea Kagwa, Ggaba road AMDA family.

I would also like to give a special welcome to our first-time guests, particularly those from St. Andrea Kaggwa. Furthermore, we are honored to have Rev. Fr. Julius Ceasar Kamukama as our principal celebrant today, leading our Mass for the first time since his ordination. We hope you feel at home, at AMDA and that you will come back to pray with us every last Sunday of the month.

I would also like to welcome back our 300 AMDA members who participated in the AMDA caravan 2023 in Ibanda District from 8th -10th September 2023. During the caravan, we engaged in several voluntary activities to strengthen the Catholic community with the people of Ibanda and Kihani Parishes, based on our seven AMDA pillars. This caravan set several records, including the highest number of caravanners (5 buses), the highest number of patients treated at the medical camp (9,334), a corporate dinner at the parish, and the highest budget. As your servants, we were amazed, and

we thank you wholeheartedly. While the detailed report is still being compiled, we can confirm that we are not in debt.

The Caravan offers a wonderful chance for us to make a meaningful impact by helping others and embodying our Christian values of compassion and kindness towards our neighbors. By utilizing all seven of AMDA's guiding principles, we can fulfill God's word as stated in Hebrews 13:16, which urges us to do good and share with others, as these actions are pleasing to God. So let's seize this opportunity to make a positive difference in the lives of those around us.

This year's Caravan needed a lot of resources (time, money, and materials) and all the required resources were fully provided by AMDA members and partners. To fund the huge budget, a number of measures were used such as;

- Each travelling member paying UGX 250,000
- Held one Jamboree
- Parishes contributing at least UGX 1,000,000 and we received a good response from the majority of parishes
- Reaching out to partners and friends

I want to express my sincere gratitude to everyone who played a part in making this

year's caravan a success. I especially want to thank our Leisure and Events Council, led by Mr. Richard Tumwesigye, for their outstanding leadership. I also want to give a special shout-out to the medical team, led by Dr. Crescent Tumuhaise, for their exceptional work at the medical camp, and to Chief Pharmacist Dr. Allen Basiima for their coordination of all the necessary medicines.

We plan to hold a Caravan partners breakfast on October 19, 2023, where we will share our progress with our partners and generate interest in the upcoming Caravan to Rushooka parish in 2024. Preparations have begun for our animation of the MEPA pilgrimage to Namugongo Martyrs Shrine, which is scheduled for November 12, 2023. The expected number of pilgrims is over 7,000, and the budget allocated for the event is slightly over shs 50 million. We kindly request your usual generosity to ensure the pilgrimage is a success.

Our next month will be animated by the Kashekuro Parish on 29th October 2022.

I wish you a blessed month ahead.

I would like to extend a warm welcome to everyone who took part in the wonderful and historic Amda Caravan to Ibanda, which took place from September 9th to 11th, 2023. I am also thankful to the AMDA Leadership for entrusting Sandeka with this important responsibility and for the support provided.

I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to the organizing committee and all our friends for their tireless efforts, especially during this busy period, which included the recent Annual Caravan. Your dedication and hard work have contributed significantly to the success of this day. Thank you all!

We would like to extend a special commendation to our esteemed member and main celebrant, Reverend Father Julius Caesar Kamukama, for accepting our invitation on such short notice. We also want to express our heartfelt appreciation for the invaluable contributions and membership of AMDA chaplains, Dr. Reverend Father Darius Magunda and Reverend Father Stephen Baryamujura. Their involvement has made St. Andereya Kagwa the "AMDA First Family."

What is St. Andereya Kagwa AMDA Family (Sandeka)?

The name St. Andereya Kagwa is derived from our Patron Saint, Andereya Kagwa, a Ugandan Martyr who was killed at the Uganda Martyrs Shrine in Munyonyo. It is said that he was originally from Hoima and had the name Andereya Kahwa, but the Baganda people referred to him as Kagwa instead.

The Sandeka family includes the entire Makindye division, encompassing areas such as Gaba Road, Muyenga, Namwongo, Bunga, Gaba, Munyonyo, Buziga, Konge,

Makindye and Nsambya. The Christians in this family initially prayed with St. Padre Pio of Entebbe Road. In 2017, Counsel Maudah Atuzarirwe (RIP) proposed the creation of the family, but unfortunately passed away before it could be realized. The family began with a small group of members who formed a WhatsApp group and prayed from their respective homes. A few months later, the former Amda Chairman Dr. Ampe Gaston and his Exco officially inaugurated the family.

AMDA's ninth caravan to Ibanda leaves Catholic Community Smiling.

The Archdiocese of Mbarara Development Association (AMDA) held her ninth caravan in Ibanda earlier this month, hosted by Ibanda Parish.

Ibanda Parish received the torch to host the 2023 Caravan at the end of the 2022 visit to Butare Parish in Buhweju District, at which His Grace, Bishop Lambert Bainomugisha, referred to the association's members as modern missionaries.

Like the previous year, while celebrating Holy Mass at Ibanda Parish, the archbishop hailed the caravanners for being practical in reaching out to their communities, sharing love, and affirming the faith in their home base parishioners.

"We thank you for coming to firm the faith among the people of Ibanda. Even those who can't see with their eyes, renew their faith by witnessing your acts of love. Our desire is for you to visit and reach all the parishes in the archdiocese." Said His Grace while delivering his Homily at the final Mass, marking the end of the caravan.

His Grace, Lambert Bainomugisha, believes that AMDA members are helping the church ensure that people can live a full life which

Jesus Christ agitates for daily.

Archbishop Bainomugisha said that missionaries came to Uganda in 1912 with Jesus Christ and that people should get him in full.

"They wanted us to have life and have it in full. People should have the energy of the body and soul. There is a big hospital in Ibanda, the Catholic Church did not put it there to make money, but they wanted people to have life and have it in full. The Catholic Church is a field hospital. You have healed people; you gave them needs of the heart and soul," he retorted.

The mass was preceded by other outreach activities, including training on economic empowerment, spiritual development, and environmental sustainability campaigns where fruit trees and natural and medicinal tree species were planted at Kihani and Ibanda parishes, and the 6th medical camp. Other activities included women's economic training, education and inspiring talks for school-going children and secondary school students.

The Medical camp, the 6th in a row was characterised by long queues of people who travelled many kilometres to access free

medical services, some of which specialised and unavailable in their rural healthcare facilities. Over 9000 people were treated for a range of health conditions, including eye care with cataract surgeries and reading glasses, dental services, cancer screening, General Medical Care, Specialist Psychiatric Care, Specialist Gynaecology Care, Ante-natal Care, Post Natal Care, TB Screening & mental health, HIV Counselling and Testing Services, Counselling services, screening for Non-Communicable Diseases and Laboratory Services among others.

"We still have a big need for health services especially in rural communities. The best way to deliver these services to the community is through religiously based organisations like churches and organisations like AMDA. This is our sixth annual medical camp and what we have witnessed is that the numbers keep growing," Dr Crescent Tumuhaise, the head of AMDA Medical Council, said.

Dr Tumuhaise attributed the high turnout at the medical camp to the public's trust in the medical services provided by religious medical services.

While explaining the works of AMDA, Dr. Fr. Darius Magunda,

the Association's Chaplain, quotes Jesus' teaching in John 10:10, "I came that you may have life and have abundantly." Fr Darius explains complete life as one that addresses the spiritual, bodily and mental needs catered for in the caravan package.

"This is why we are not only preaching the word of God but also providing the other needs. We know that our people cannot only feed on the word of God, they need to be treated; they need good health for their minds and souls to engage in productive work," says Fr. Magunda.

The Executive Director of Mulago National Referral Hospital, Dr Rosemary Byanyima, also a member of AMDA, participating in the medical camp, appealed to the public to improve their health-seeking behaviours to get early disease diagnosis and better outcomes.

"We need to invest in programmes and create awareness for public health and early testing and diagnosis of diseases such as cancers, prolonged cough, diabetes and blood pressure because treating these and chances of cure are high when diseases are still in early stages," she said.

She appealed to the Government to increase access to specialized care services like cancer screening in rural areas where most people need the services, noting that the number of people who turned up for treatment are an indicator of the extent of healthcare shortfalls in the community.

The activities of the 3-day caravan aim to empower communities back home in different aspects of life aligned to our 7 pillars. To date, nine caravans have been held in 23 parishes, following the maiden visit to Rugazi Parish in 2013, Buhungiro, Birunduma and Kyoga in 2014, Rwera, Kagamba,

Rushooka and Ntungamo in 2015, Kitabi, Mutara, Nyakishojwa and Bubangizi in 2016, Kazo, Rushere and Kitura in 2017, Rushanje and Rwoho in 2018, Mushanga and Kakindo in 2019, Butare, Bihanga, Nyakitoko and Kashorero in 2022.

The caravan, a flagship of AMDA which happens every year, is a unique outreach adventure through which AMDA reaches out to members of the archdiocese for total transformation through the seven pillars of Unity, Spiritual Development, Leadership Development, Economic Empowerment, Education Development, Health & Wellness and Environmental Sustainability.

"The caravan presents a huge opportunity for us to create lasting impressions by transforming lives and demonstrating our Christian responsibility of knowing who our neighbour is," said Mr Chris Gumisiriza, AMDA Chairperson.

He believes that for the communities to live better, they need essential services like health, food, education, and God, among others.

"It is the idea of the caravan that enables AMDA to put into practice all her seven pillars at ago, thus contributing to fulfilling what the word of God requires us to do," he says.

On the sidelines, there was a legal clinic providing free legal consultation. About 85 cases were registered, and these are being followed up in collaboration with the Legal Aid Project to ensure justice is served.

The Dean of Ibanda Parish, Father Paul Mutume appreciates the AMDA for the continued efforts to better their parishes through a holistic approach like the caravan which emphasises unity, spiritual development, the health of body and soul, and economic empowerment, among others.


